4. During the holiday half day schedule the standard duty day begins at 0630 hrs and ends at 1200 hrs. Normal training, staff coordination, mission support, and readiness activities will be complete by 1200 daily. Leaders at all levels are expected to personally observe and enforce this schedule. Without exception, units will not implement a “day on, day off” schedule as an alternative.

In accordance with 101<sup>st</sup> Abn Div (AASLT) & Ft. Campbell FY25-26 Annual Training Guidance, Enclosure 2 (Empowered Leader – Leader Development Guidance for FY25-26, para 8. Protected Time): Eagle Day will occur on the first Friday of each month. When the first Friday falls on a DONSA it will occur on the second Friday of the month. Eagle Days consist of an entire duty day of training and will not encroach on Eagle Family Time. Eagle Days are focused on squad and platoon level engagements but are managed at the Brigade echelon. Minimizing other activities on Eagle Days, including SSA activities to 02 Priority parts processing and external deliveries, is the responsibility of unit commanders. Eagle Days will be supported with Division and Garrison resources, training materials, and subject matter experts upon request. Commanders are encouraged to highlight activities and lessons in bi-weekly SITREPs
