REGULARLY SCHEDULED PROGRAMS

Baby & Me Lapsit (ages 0 – 3 yrs)

Tuesday 10:00 AM || Wednesday 10:00 AM and 1:30 PM

Bond with your baby and introduce them to the wonders of reading when you join us for simple stories, songs, rhymes, and fun.

Storytime (ages 3 -5 yrs)

Thursday 10:30 AM and 1:30 PM

This program combines reading, physical activity, and a craft or STEAM project to keep the children engaged. It promotes early literacy and developmental skills as well as encourages social interaction.

Dungeons & Dragons (D&D)

Saturday 12:00 PM – 4:00 PM

This program is designed to bring together all levels of D&D players for a weekly campaign or one-shot campaign set in D&D 5E.

Victorian Teatime Book Club (ages 13 yrs and up)

3rd Wednesday of every month 5:00 PM

A celebration of Victorian authors from all nations active during Queen Victoria's lifetime (1819-1901). Participants will meet to discuss their passion for the Victorian era over a good cup of hot tea and a biscuit. Costumes encouraged.

Creative Play for Toddlers (ages 3 and under)

2nd Monday of every month at 10:00 AM

This program is designed to allow little ones to explore and discover sensory play and artistic expression using a variety of "toddler safe" materials.

Makerspace Programs (ages 6 and up)

2nd Sunday of every month at 2:00PM and 2nd Tuesday at 5:30PM

These programs may be a craft, art or even STEAM activity. The intent is to introduce and encourage patrons to explore and develop an interest in a variety of arts and crafts.

Homeschool Science Club (Middle School: 5th – 8th grade)

1st Monday of each month 2:00 PM

This is a 2-hour program. 1st half of program will be doing the experiment/activity. 2nd half will be planning the activity for following month.

Homeschool Book Club (Middle School: 5th – 8th grade)

2nd Monday of each month 2:00 PM

The participants will decide what books they want to read based on a genre, author or subject matter. Library staff will provide guidance, but students are encouraged to take the lead in book selections and discussions.
