Academic Onefile

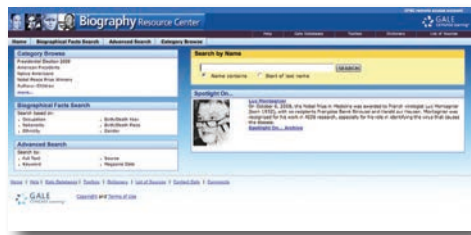

GreenFILE

GreenFILE offers well-researched information covering all aspects of the human impact on the environment.

Health & Wellness Resource Center

Provides instant access to trusted medical reference materials. Material contained in this resource center is intended for informational purposes only.

History Resource Center: United States

Provides integrated access to over 4,000 historical (primary) documents, articles from more than 30 reference titles, and over 110 full-text journal entries covering themes, events, individuals and periods in U.S. history from pre-Colonial times to the present.

History Resource Center: World

From ancient Europe to Latin America and from the Far East to the Renaissance, world history curricula is supported with over 1,800 primary sources, over 27 reference titles and more than 110 journals.

Home Improvement Reference Center

Offers 26 major reference works in full text with more than 10,000 images and full-text magazines (e.g. This Old House) for home improvement, assistance on maintenance, remodeling, electrical work, plumbing, decorating home & garden, etc.

Junior Edition K-12

Designed for students in junior high and middle school, this database contains a variety of indexed and full-text magazines, newspapers and

reference books for information on current events, the arts, science, popular culture, health, people, government, history, sports and more.

Military and Education Research Library Network (MERLN)

A Web site devoted to international military education outreach. It represents a consortium of military libraries that work together to provide access to a variety of unique resources.

Military & Intelligence Database

A custom collection of full-text articles and journals aimed at military and intelligence.

MyILibrary

As a unique offering to the military community, the Department of Defense is making available over 400 e-books including Encyclopedia Britannica, 95 books covering legal issues, 24 foreign language guides, and 169 “For Dummies...” books.

NetLibrary – Audio Books & E-books Collection

Over 2,650 full-text electronic versions of published books such as "ASVAB Core Review," computer books, resume books and 213 Cliffs Notes.

Opposing Viewpoints

Complete source for information on social issues, including articles, topic overviews, statistics, primary documents, links to Web sites, and full-text magazine and newspaper articles.

Safari Books Online

Safari is an e-reference library where you can search across thousands of books from O’Reilly, Addison-Wesley, Cisco Press, Microsoft Press and more. Read books cover to cover or flip directly to the section you need in seconds.

Science Resource Center

Science Resource Center organizes thousands of topic overviews, experiments, biographies, pictures, illustrations and the latest scientific developments in articles from over 200 magazines and academic journals and links to quality Web sites.

Small Engine Repair Reference Center

This comprehensive resource contains 410 full text reference books with original photos and illustrations for small engine repair assistance, including: ATVs, commercial mowers, generators, motorcycles, marine, outdoor power equipment, personal watercraft/jet ski, snow blowers, tillers and other small engines.

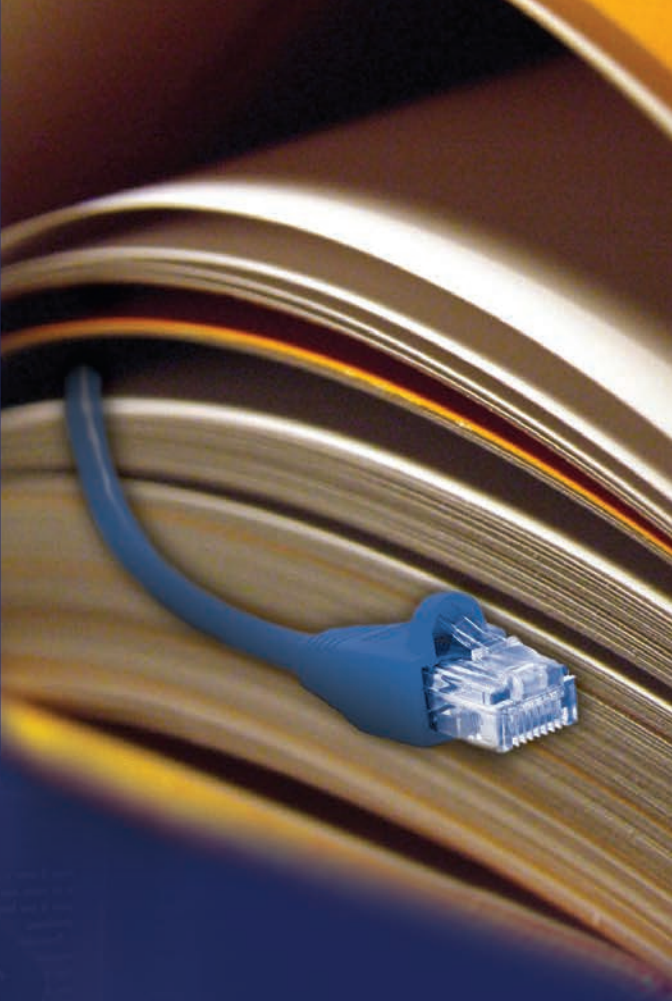

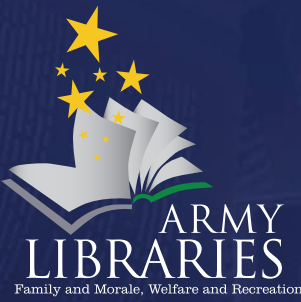
