

TRICARE Pharmacy Changes

- On Feb. 1, copayments for prescription drugs at TRICARE Pharmacy Home Delivery and retail pharmacies increased.

- Clarksville Montgomery County School System
 - With a student population of almost 35,000 students, CMCSS is pursuing the construction of classroom additions to 4 schools.
 - They include: a 12-classroom wing at Minglewood Elementary, Barkers Mill Elementary and Northeast High as well as a 10-classroom wing at Northeast Middle; Recommendation by the Montgomery County Commission's Budgets Committee and goes before the full Commission for a vote on 12 Feb.
