







- **Location:** Taylor Youth Center, 80 Texas Ave

- A new Adult Immunization Service is scheduled to open soon at the Town Center Pharmacy
- Provides adults without access to primary care for routine and adult immunizations the ability to receive immunizations from a clinical pharmacist at the Town Center
- Boosts immunization access for beneficiaries not on TRICARE Prime or not enrolled at the MTF
- Also reduces the Defense Department's cost in the network for TRICARE beneficiaries needing vaccines

Continuing Medical Education Day

- 27 April Blanchfield Army Community Hospital personnel will receive annual continuing medical education
- Primary and specialty care services will not be open, additional providers will be available in the Emergency Center for acute needs


