



- Registration process for incoming students to FCS
 - Age Requirements:
 - 4 years old by September 1 to attend pre-kindergarten
 - 5 years old by September 1 to enroll in kindergarten
 - 6 years old by September 1 to attend first grade
- Required documents needed for registration:
 - Birth certificate
 - Active Duty status of Military Sponsor
 - Housing Authorization with child's name listed
 - Certificate showing updated and required immunizations (due within 30 days of registering student)

The registration process is done at your child's school. If you need to know what school your child will attend you may call (270-439-1927) after you receive your housing assignment.

- Withdrawal Process:
 - Give the school at least 2 weeks notice of your student's last day of attendance
 - Pay any outstanding cafeteria debts
 - Turn in all books and materials into appropriate school personnel
