Introducing TRICARE Open Season

Open season is an annual period when you can enroll in or change a health insurance plan for the next year.



- TRICARE beneficiaries will experience TRICARE Open Season for the first time Nov. 12–Dec 10, 2018.
- Enrollment changes made during TRICARE Open Season will go into effect on Jan. 1, 2019.



Introducing FEDVIP

 The TRICARE Retiree Dental Program (TRDP) is ending 31 Dec 2018.

Eligible beneficiaries must take action to enroll in FEDVIP to continue dental coverage. There is **no automatic enrollment** for current TRDP enrollees.

- With FEDVIP, some TRICARE beneficiaries are now eligible for FEDVIP vision coverage.
- Eligible TRICARE beneficiaries can:
 - Enroll in FEDVIP during Federal Benefits Open Season for dental and/or vision coverage starting 1 Jan 2019.
 - Federal Benefits Open Season runs from 12 Nov–10Dec 2018.
 - Choose from 10 dental carriers and four vision carriers.
