Homeschool Programs For Middle Schoolers

Science Club

They will have to determine what materials they will need and theorize what results they expect. Parents can incorporate these projects into their homeschool curriculum.

Participants will meet the following month to discuss their books. The meetings will have guidance from library staff but will strongly encourage student lead discussions.
