DAY 01/SAT: USA DEPARTURE

Make your way to your gateway airport to board your flight to Athens. Enjoy in-flight meals and services. Overnight onboard the flight.

DAY 02/SUN: ATHENS (ARRIVAL)

Upon arrival in Greece's capital city of Athens today you will be met by our company representative and transferred to your hotel. Overnight in Athens

Optional: Half day sightseeing tour of Athens including Acropolis USD 90 per person (On SIC Basis)

This tour starts with a short stop to Panathinaiko Stadium where the first Olympic Games took place in 1896. Continue with a panoramic drive passing by ex Royal Palace, Zappion Hall, Roman Temple of Olympian Zeus, National Temple of Hadrian Arch, St. Paul's church, Tomp of the Unknown Soldier, Schliemann's House, Catholic Cathedral, academy, University and National Library. Make our way to the archaeological site of Acropolis, an UNESCO's world heritage monument and visit Propylae, Temple of Athena Nike, Erechtheion with its porch of Maidens and of course the Parthenon. Continue with a pleasant short walk passing by herodion and Dionysus Theatre, in order to visit the Acropolis Museum. Main attractions such as votines, artefacts of every day life, statues from archaic period, Caryatids, and of course the Parthenon hall with the metopes, the pediments and the frieze will impress you.

DAY 03/MON: PIRE PORT, ATHENS (EMBARKATION) -

MYKONOS (B/L/D)

Today you will be transferred to the port in Pireasue to embark on a cruise that will take you out into the Aegean Sea to the beautiful island of Mykonos. Spend your evening at leisure exploring this magnificent island. Mykonos boasts splendid beaches, historic churches and quaint narrow streets laced with whitewashed houses, where artists and jetsetters alike mingle. Windmills give an extra romantic touch to this lovely island as do the open air tavernas, offering an array of Greek delicacies. It is truly an island paradise. Overnight on board

DAY 04/TUE: MYKONOS - KUSADASI - PATMOS (B/L/D)
Kusadasi Cruise Arrival: 7.30 am | Cruise Departure: 1.00 pm
Patmos Cruise Arrival: 5.45 pm | Cruise Departure: 9.30 pm

The first port of call today is the Turkish port of Kusadasi where you will participate in the Ancient Ephesus through the Ages - Hellenistic/Roman tour. The journey begins from Kusadasi to Ancient Ephesus along fragrant roads lined with olive trees. One of the 12 cities of lona, this is a stunning marvel in the hills above the Aegean coast, one of the world's largest open-air archeological museums. Founded by the ancient Greeks circa 2000 BC. Ephesus was dedicated to the goddess Artemis, and its Artemision, a temple in her honor, took 120 years to complete and was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. You can wander through the Odeon and the Prytaneion, then stroll between the marble colonnades of Curetes Street to visit Trajan's Fountain, Hadrian's Temple, the Scholastica Baths and the astonishing Terrace Houses. Nearby, where Curetes Street becomes Marble Street, is the spectacular Library of Celsus, which has been almost entirely reconstructed, and the Agora. Every step here takes you deeper into the Hellenistic, Roman and early-Christian eras; you'll notice inscriptions on many of the city's columns. The Great Theater of Ephesus, where St. Paul once preached, was carved into the side of Mt. Pion in the 4th century BC. Before returning to the cruise time permitting you will be able to walk through the Covered Bazaar in Kusadasi. where, you will be able bargain for jewellery, Turkish carpets, cosmetics or leather products at the little shops. The cruise will then sail on to the Greek island of Patmos, where you will have the option to visit the Monastery and Grotto of St. John, where he lived and recorded the Book of the Revelation. After the tour, you will re-join your cruise ship in time for a delicious dinner. Overnight on board

DAY 05/WED: PATMOS - RHODES (B/L/D)

Early this morning call in to the magnificent island of the roses for the Medieval tour - Acropolis of Lindos and the Citadel of the Knights. DAY 07/FRI: ATHENS

Upon arrival at Piraeus port you will be met by our company representative and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to explore this vibrant and historical city at your leisure. Overnight in Athens

DAY 08/SAT: ATHENS (B/-/-)

After breakfast enjoy a morning city tour of Greece's capital city, Athens, that includes a visit to the world-famous Acropolis. The tour begins in front of the House of Parliament in Syntagma Square, where you will see the Monument of the Unknown Soldier before enjoying a walk through

the National Gardens to see the Zappeion, the Temple of Olympian Zeus and Hadrian's Arch. You will then enter the Plaka neighbourhood of the city as you travel to the Acropolis, the ancient citadel overlooking the city. You will see the Propylaia, the Temple of Nike, the Parthenon, the Athenian Agora, the Observatories, the Hill of Democracy (Pnyx), Mars and Philopappou Hill, the Odeon of Herodes Atticus and the Theater of Dionysus. After the tour, you will return to your hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Athens

DAY 09/SUN: ATHENS (B/-/-)

Spend the day at leisure to explore Athens on your own or join the following optional tour. Overnight in Athens

Optional - Full Day Tour of Delphi (w/ lunch) - 115 USD on an S.I.C basis

Explore one of the most famous UNESCO world heritage sites with a day tour from Athens to magical Delphi. Depart via the national highway passing by Thebes, Levadia for a short stop, before arriving in Delphi at around noon. Famous for its theatre, Temple of Apollo and ancient ruins, Delphi was considered the centre of the earth and the universe and played a central role in the classical Greek world. After, pass by Castalia Spring, visit at the archaeological site of Temple of Apollo famous for its oracle, Athenian Treasure and the Museum of Delphi with its spectacular finds, including the unique bronze Charioteer the Naxian Sphinx and the Statue of Antinoos. After lunch, return to Athens via the picturesque village of Arachova, built on the south slopes of Parnassus, well known for its attractive hand-woven carpets, rugs and quilts, as well as for its wine and cheese.

DAY 10/MON: ATHENS DEPARTURE (B/-/-)
