SUD Treatment

- BH has developed 2 paths for treatment:
 - Mandatory (Enrolled) Care and Voluntary Care
- Encourages personal responsibility to seek help earlier in their illness
- Maintains full accountability for indiscipline events, full commander visibility on all Soldiers with illicit drug use and on all Soldiers with duty impairment or safety risk due to any substance use
- Improves Soldier readiness by decreasing unnecessary enrollment & deployment ineligibility





Community Wellness

How is the SUDCC Voluntary Program important to Fort Campbell? We will be better able to decrease risk for our soldiers and families adding to the health and wellness of our community.

- Untreated Alcohol and Drug use can surface through negative behavior with serious consequences on health and readiness.
- 31–33% of all spouse abuse incidents involved alcohol at the time of the incident
- SHARP: 2015 RAND Report on Sexual Assault in the DoD
- Overall, 43% of sexual assault cases involved either the victim or perpetrator, or both, using alcohol at the time of the incident
- SUICIDE: 2014 DoDSER Annual Report
- 54% of reported suicide attempts that led to hospitalization involved drugs or alcohol as the suicide attempt method

- Special Elections and School News
- The Montgomery County Election Commission will host two special election dates for Congressman Mark Green's unexpired term in the State Senate. A primary election March 7 and a general election April 23. This is the state senate seat that represents Montgomery, Houston and Stewart counties and has great influence statewide for Fort Campbell.
- Early voting for the March 7 primary election will begin February 15 through March 2 and will take place at the election commission in Veterans Plaza. The primary voting on March 7 will take place at all voting precincts. The majority of the voting precincts are in schools resulting in no school for CMCSS students on March 7 or April 23.
