Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP) Training

The purpose of the Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP) is to provide a service member or Department of the Army civilian with a point of contact at their gaining installation; assisting them from pre-arrival to settling into their new unit and community.

Sponsorship is important as it helps to ease transition, facilitate colleague relationships and can even reduce culture shock from overseas moves or as a newcomer to the Army Family.

Being connected to the available resources is invaluable during a permanent change of station (PCS) move. Without this access to information and assistance, the implications (especially financially) of making an uninformed decision can have a lasting negative impact.

ACS Relocation Readiness supports the TASP by providing service members with a number of Sponsorship training opportunities along with assisting them with their Sponsorship duties:

As well as briefings to all Newcomers at Kalsu Replacement Company, we offer classroom Unit Sponsorship Training upon request and Unit Sponsorship Coordinator (USC) training which is a Unit TASP Coordinator's opportunity to train a number of sponsors at once to support effectively matching incoming service members and their Families using the tool in Army Career Tracker (ACT).



This enables Sponsors to relate with rank, experience level and Family circumstances and therefore, pre-empt required information and questions.

With an added emphasis being placed on the importance of Sponsorship and the mandatory requirements being put in place to ensure that Sponsors are assigned, this is the chance to take advantage of the training available through the ACS Relocation Readiness Program!
