

S.A.F.E. Fort Campbell Seatbelts Are For Everybody

S.A.F.E. Fort Campbell

- 1. Pre-Survey (14-16 & 24-25 JAN 2019)
 - Assess FTCKY seat belt utilization percentage by conducting random sampling of typical Mon-Fri, 5 day work week, morning, afternoon, and evening, to compare to National and State percentages.
 - National 89.7%, Tennessee 88.5%, Kentucky 86.8%
 - 10,180 total vehicles were observed, excluding apparent commercial, government (GSA), and military vehicles.
 - 7,638 (85.39%) drivers were observed properly wearing seat belt.
 - 1,236 (12.14%) drivers were undetermined.
 - 82.57 % passengers were observed properly wearing seat belt.
- 2. Information & Education (28 JAN 24 MAR 2019)
 - Educate the FTCKY Community IOT alter driver behavior to embrace safe driving habits both on and off the installation there by saving lives.



S.A.F.E. Fort Campbell

- 3. Zero Tolerance Enforcement (25 MAR 14 APR 2019)
 - Utilizing proactive enforcement strategies to aggressively target drivers and passengers in violation IOT modify driver behavior to embrace safe driving habits both on and off the installation there by saving lives.
- 4. Post Survey (22-26 APR 2019)
 - Reassess FTCKY seat belt utilization percentage to determine effectiveness of campaign.


