Effective April 2019



POLICES & PROCEDURES

No more than four players per group; singles and twosomes will be paired up.

Singles or twosomes do not have priority on the course.

Each player must have their own bag and clubs.

Minimum age to be on the course is seven (7) years old and accompanied by an adult guardian. You must be fifteen (15) or older in order to play unaccompanied.

FOOD & DRINK POLICY

- No outside food and beverages (including alcohol) allowed on Cole Park Golf property.
- Private coolers are prohibited.



GOLF CART POLICY

Players and guests must be at least 16 with a valid driver's license in order to rent or operate a golf cart.

No more than two (2) riders per cart.

Cart fees are charged on a per rider basis, i.e. each person is charged for a seat in the cart.

Non-playing riders are charged as well, regardless of age.

LOCAL RULES OF PLAY

USGA rules apply with the addition of posted local rules.

White Stakes - Out Of Bounds

Red Stakes - Lateral Water Hazard

Yellow Stakes - Water Hazard

A ball coming to rest on or beyond Lee Road and Bastogne Avenue is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

All measurements are to the middle of the green.

Red - 100 yards

White - 150 yards

Blue - 200 yards

Gold - 250 yards



RAIN CHECK POLICY

In the case of inclement weather or call to duty or emergencies, a credit will be issued for the holes not played. The amount of the rain check will be equal to the fees paid for the holes not played (i.e. if \$26 was paid for 18 holes with cart, the fee would be \$1.45 per hole. If the player had 8 holes remaining, the rain check issued would be \$11.60).

If the first three holes have not been played the player will be issued a rain check for the entire amount paid.

Rain checks will not be issued for slow play.



DRESS CODE POLICY

Proper attire must be worn on the grounds and course at all times. At all times, we ask you to please respect the course as well as yourself and others.

MEN'S DRESS CODE

Suitable golf attire required. Military uniforms, including PTs, are not to be worn during play on course. Men's shirts must have sleeves. Cutoff pants or shirts are strictly prohibited.

LADIES' DRESS CODE

Suitable golf attire required. Short shorts, halter tops, spaghetti strap tops, or other revealing attire is prohibited. Ladies' shirts must cover midriffs and sleeveless shirts must have a collar. Military uniforms are not to be worn during play.

SHOE POLICY

Shoes must be suitable for playing golf. Boots, lug sole shoes, or metal spikes are not allowed.
