To Exercise MSP Eligibility, Military Spouses will Complete the Military Spouse PPP Self-Certification Checklist, with all other required documentation, when applying to vacancy announcements via <https://www.usajobs.gov/>

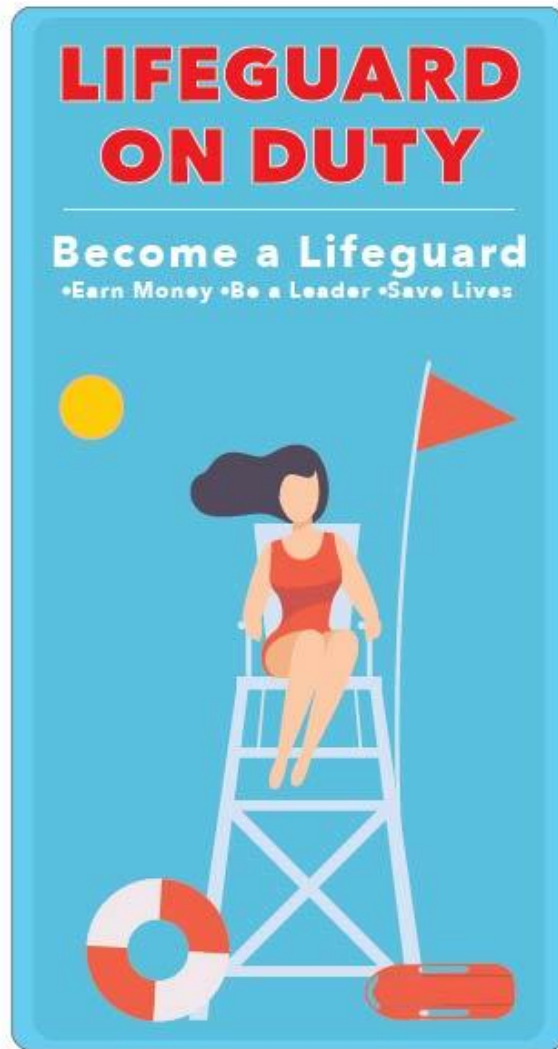
