





PPP Streamlining Initiative

Military Spouse Changes

- Effective 01 April 2019 all Program S Registrants will be Deactivated
- Military Spouse will no longer be required to report to a Civilian Personnel Advisory Center (CPAC)
- To Exercise MSP Eligibility, Military Spouses will Complete the Military Spouse PPP Self-Certification Checklist, with all other required documentation, when applying to vacancy announcements via <https://www.usajobs.gov/>

Big Difference Between PPP-S and USAJOBS and MSP

The new USAJOBS Military Spouse Preference application process is **WAY** easier than PPP-S

- The application is online, instead of an in-person or email meeting
- Each resume can be targeted toward a specific position
- Each announcement is selected by Military Spouse, based on interest in the position
- Results will come to Military Spouse via emails and will be viewable in the results section of the USAJOBS profile

SUMMARY:
Welcome to Fort Campbell! Families arriving to the Fort Campbell area have several educational choices. Families choosing to reside on the installation, can enroll and attend the Department of Defense Fort Campbell Schools grades pre-K through 12th. If they will be moving into on post housing, within 90 days. For those choosing to reside in Kentucky or Tennessee there are 6 districts to choose from: Christian County (14 schools), Trigg County (4 schools), Todd County (4 schools), Clarksville/Montgomery (19 schools), Cheatham (14 schools), and Stewart County schools (6 schools). They are all grant schools with awesome educational values. Families that decide to reside in off post housing are encouraged to research local schools prior to selecting a place to live. School districts generally do not allow out of district enrollment. Please double check with the Fort Campbell School Support Services or the district's webpage to determine the school district zone that coincides with your residence.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION:
At what age can my child start school?
In Tennessee, children entering kindergarten shall be five (5) years of age on or before August 15th of the current kindergarten term. In Kentucky, children entering kindergarten shall be five (5) years of age on or before August 1 of the current kindergarten term. DODEA Fort Campbell children entering kindergarten shall be five (5) years of age on or before September 1.

What is required for enrollment?
1. Birth Certificate
2. Immunization record
3. Copy of the child's physical exam
4. Proof of Parent/Custodian address (two forms of residency information)
5. Power of Attorney For Care of a Minor Child form (required in certain circumstances)

How do I enroll for school?
Where you live will determine where your children will attend school. Living in Clarksville/Montgomery County, use the on-line registration website to start enrollment (www.montgomeryschools.net), then enter your address on the bus and zoning page: www.cmcs.net. For all other districts, contact the district office websites listed on the School Liaison Officer at 270-798-9874 for enrollment dates and times.

SCHOOL CHOICE OPTIONS:
• **Public School Choice:** For high school students, please check www.cmcs.net to see which schools host the Career Technical Choice (i.e. Automotive, Cosmetology). In Kentucky choice schools are open to middle and high school students through the guidance counselor.
• **Private Schools:** Several private school choices available—please see www.privateschoolreview.com to look at choices. Also view www.militarychild.org to see what private schools have partnered with Fort Campbell.
• **Home Schools:** Families can elect to home school their children. www.homeschooling-tennessee.org/ and www.education.ky.gov/
• **Charter Schools:** No charter schools currently available in Montgomery, Cheatham, and Stewart County.

REMEMBERS:
• Enroll your child as soon as possible. It is not recommended that you delay enrolling your child when you transition to a new installation. Some families have delayed enrolling their child for up to a month and have missed their child repeating a grade.
• After you enroll, please return to the school and provide the school with updated contact information. Schools often call Fort Campbell School Support Services trying to locate a parent in an emergency—because the parent has failed to provide updated information to the school.
• Fort Campbell School Support Services cannot supersede school policies. Please be familiar with school policies and understand that the installation and Fort Campbell families cannot supersede school policies.

OTHER SCHOOL DATA: In order to meet the requirements for receiving course credits and/or graduation, students in high school must enroll each class 50% of the school days per semester (minus the time of enrollment).
High school students: 7 Period schedule and modified block schedule in DODESS High School. Pre-K: Federal program, available in DODEA schools, limited slots in other districts if available. Maximum Classroom size: Varies by school district.

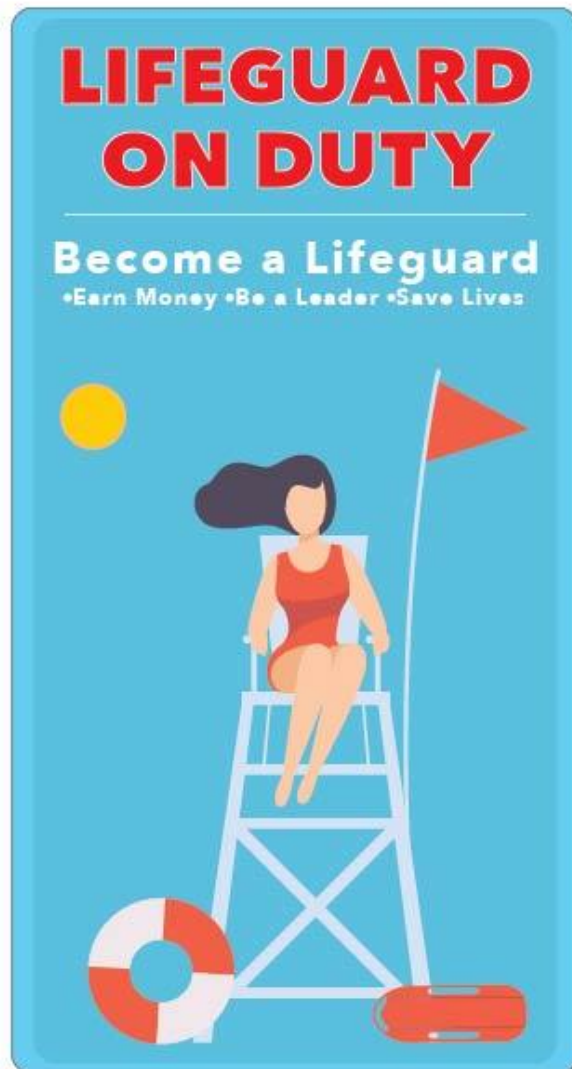

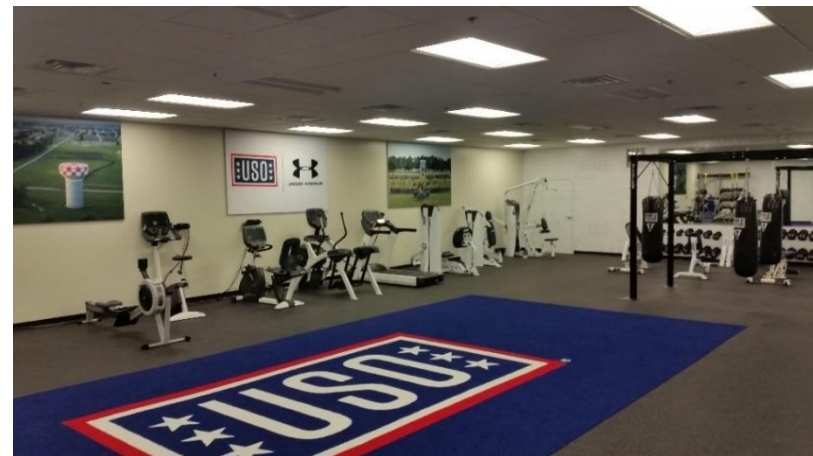
