Army changes substance abuse treatment



- Soldiers can now voluntarily seek alcohol-related behavioral healthcare without being mandatorily enrolled in a substance abuse treatment program.
- Army Secretary Mark T. Esper signed directive March 25
- New policy encourages Soldiers to take personal responsibility and seek help earlier, improving readiness by decreasing unnecessary enrollment and deployment limitations.

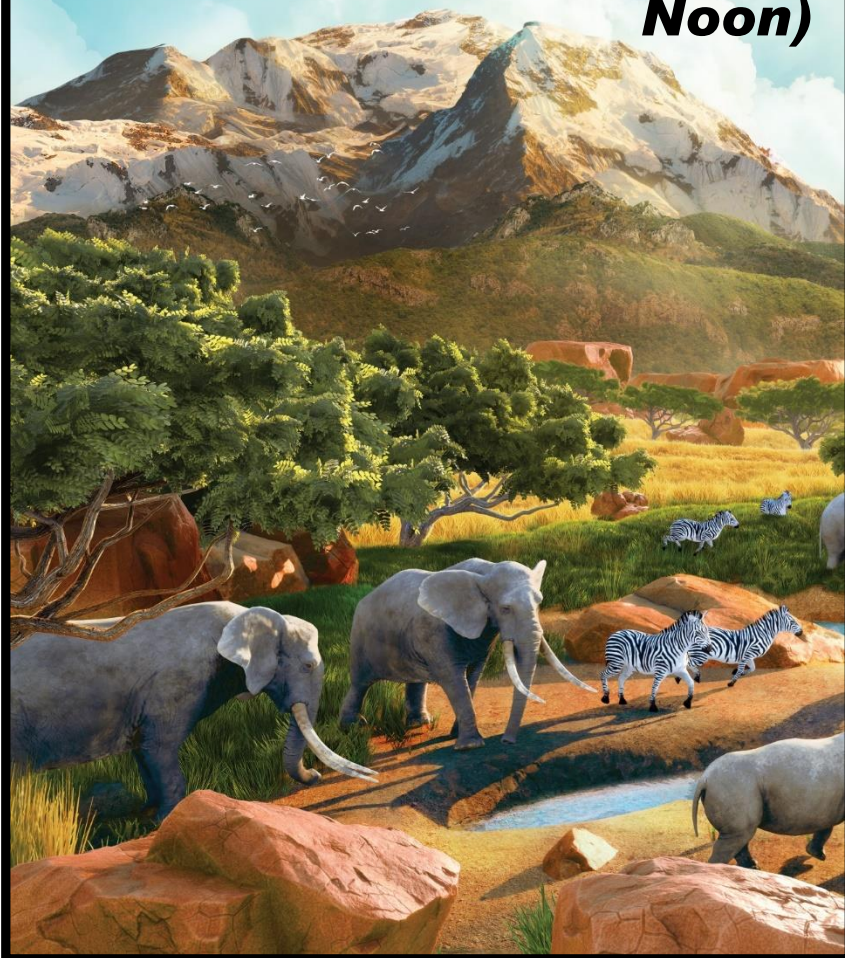

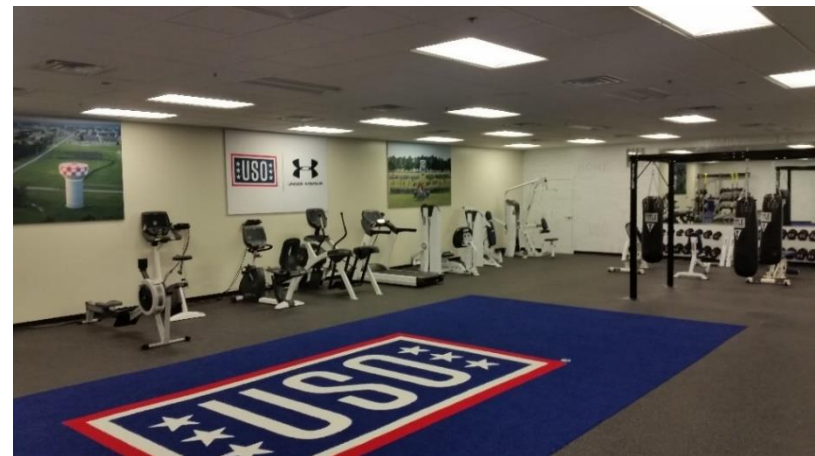
