Check base regulations re: breed restrictions and number of pets allowed per household before getting a pet. Montgomery County Animal Control is required to report any breach of regulations to Department of Emergency Services. Pets must be microchipped and vaccinated for rabies.

Cats and dogs housed on base must be registered through the Ft. Campbell Veterinary Clinic.

Keep pets on a leash and restrained even when on your property. Do not leave pets outdoors unattended. For pets outdoors, make sure they always have fresh drinkable water available a dog house for shelter, and are properly restrained to prevent them from leaving your property.
