## Will patient support change?

- **BACH will transition to the DHA authority on Oct. 1, 2019 (as well as all other stateside military medical treatment facilities transition)**
- On Oct. 1, 2019, nothing is going to change for BACH patients
- This is going to be a seamless process for patients
- Administratively, our team will work through changes in reporting and leadership authority, but our mission remains the same
- Our mission remains:
  - Support the warfighter
  - Care for our warfighters' Families
  - Care for the patient

### **Missed Drug Take Back Day?**

Properly dispose of your expired, unused or unwanted medicine by dropping them in the Drug Drop Boxes placed inside the hospital's Main Pharmacy or Town Center Pharmacy during business hours. Accepted items include: prescription medications, controlled substance medication, over-the-counter medication, vitamins, medicated ointment/lotion, liquid medication in leak-proof containers and transdermal skin patches. *Items not accepted*

*include: needles, thermometers, contraband drugs, infectious waste/medical waste, personal care products, business waste, hydrogen peroxide, aerosol cans, and inhalers.*

Campbell Stray Animal Facility is open for pet reclaims and inquiries Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. They are working to conduct adoptions at the facility in the near future. For animal related questions, contact your housing manager or Department of Emergency Services. You can also reach the on call Animal Control Officer at 931-472-5820
- \* Check base regulations re: breed restrictions and number of pets allowed per household before getting a pet. Montgomery County Animal Control is required to report any breach of regulations to Department of Emergency Services. Pets must be microchipped and vaccinated for rabies.
- \* Cats and dogs housed on base must be registered through the Ft. Campbell Veterinary Clinic.
- \* Keep pets on a leash and restrained even when on your property. Do not leave pets outdoors unattended. For pets outdoors, make sure they always have fresh drinkable water available a dog house for shelter, and are properly restrained to prevent them from leaving your property.
- \* If you are interested in adopting a new pet, please visit our main shelter at 616 N. Spring St. in Clarksville. We have many wonderful puppies, kittens, dogs and cats available for adoption and the Adoption Fee, Microchip, Spay/Neuter, and Rabies vaccination is included in the adoption fees.

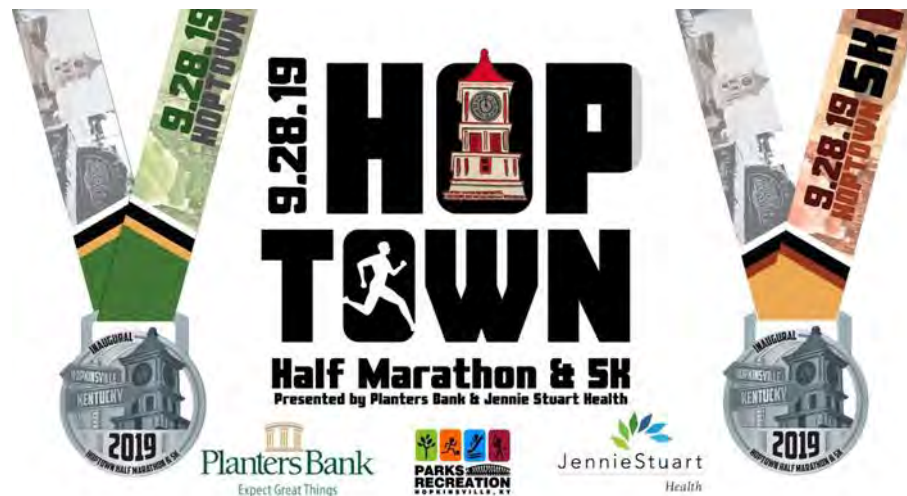
