Halloween Fire Safety:

AVOID oversized or long trailing fabric when picking a costume. Ensure eye holes are large enough to see out. Dried flowers, cornstalks and crepe paper are highly flammable. It is safest to use a flashlight or battery operated candle in a jack-o-lantern. If using real candles, keep pumpkins far away from anything that can burn. Remember to keep exits clear of decorations. Tell children to stay away from open flames.

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK: 05-12 October

Ensure there are working smoke alarms on every level of the home, and in every bedroom and sleeping area. There should be two ways out of every room. Practice escape plan, at a minimum, twice a year with all family members.
