BACH Patient Centered Medical Homes are offering the flu vaccine to their assigned patients during clinic hours. Flu vaccines can be given on a walk-in basis or during scheduled well visit appointments. Active Duty Soldiers should follow their unit's guidance as to when and where they will receive their flu vaccine.
