## **Homeschool Programs**

### For Middle Schoolers

#### Science Club

1st Monday of each month 2:00 PM.

The second part will be for the students to decide what experiment or activity they would like to do the following month. They will have to determine what materials they will need and theorize what results they expect. Parents can incorporate these projects into their homeschool curriculum.
