Homeschool Programs For Middle Schoolers

Science Club

1st Monday of each month 2:00 PM.

This is a 2-hour program. The first part will be for students to conduct an experiment or activity (i.e. build a robot). The second part will be for the students to decide what experiment or activity they would like to do the following month. They will have to determine what materials they will need and theorize what results they expect. Parents can incorporate these projects into their homeschool curriculum.

Book Club

2nd Monday of each month 2:00 PM.

The participants will choose from a selection of recommended books. Books will be based on specific genre or themes rather than having everyone read the exact same book. Participants will meet the following month to discuss their books. The meetings will have guidance from library staff but will strongly encourage student lead discussions.
