Professional Development

Who: Any USAG employee that has held an Army Civilian position, or a combination of Army Civilian positions, for a total of **2** or more years.

Employee must:

- Have completed CES requirements (at least the DL portion) relevant to their grade and supervisory responsibilities.
- **Demonstrate exceptional character, commitment, potential for** growth, and future leadership capability within the command.

What: The LDAP program will provide opportunities for learning and development for its participants in order to achieve fully trained, multifunctional, and responsive employees. The duration of this program is 30-90 days.

When: Applications can be downloaded on the Civilian Employee One Stop Shop in the Professional Development Tab and will be accepted year round.

Why: The purpose of the program is to identify and develop ex-

ceptional employees and future leaders; develop an ag**ile, adaptive workforce; and to institute and promote a culture of coaching and mentoring USAG-wide.**

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
