## Regularly Scheduled Events

### **Baby & Me Lapsit (ages 0 – 3 yrs)**

Tuesday 10:00 AM || Wednesday 10:00 AM and 1:30 PM

Bond with your baby and introduce them to the wonders of reading when you join us for simple stories, songs, rhymes, and fun.

### **Storytime (ages 3 -5 yrs)**
